Guyana Civil Aviation Authority (G.C.A.A.)
Requirements to be applied during temporary restriction of flights within
Georgetown Flight Information Region

Special Authorised Flights

All private flights or charter flights require approval from the Minister with responsibility for Civil Aviation. The following requirements shall apply:

- ✓ A formal request is to be made to the Director General, GCAA at least three (3) working days prior to the proposed flight;
- ✓ Completion of GCAA Landing Permission Form, GCAA - 4106A and submit the required documents, along with a filed flight plan consistent with the type of flight highlighted;
- ✓ COVID-19 test for all crew and passengers prior to arrival within the last fourteen (14) days;
- ✓ No objection from the Cheddi Jagan International Airport (C.J.I.A) or Eugene F Correia International Airport (E.F.C.I.A);
- ✓ No objection from the Ministry of Public Health;
- ✓ No objection from Immigration;
- ✓ No objection from Customs.

Flights on behalf of foreign missions in Guyana must be directed through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

**TO OPERATORS CONDUCTING DOMESTIC AIR TRANSPORT DURING
COVID- 19 PANDEMIC.**

AUTHORITY

The Director General of the Guyana Civil Aviation Authority (GCAA) hereby issues this Directive under the authority of section 143 (1) (a) of the Civil Aviation Act 2018.

APPLICABILITY

This DIRECTIVE is applicable to all air operators conducting air transport operations within Guyana.

EFFECTIVITY

This DIRECTIVE is effective from **00:00hrs on Thursday 4th June 2020 until 23:59hrs Wednesday 17th June 2020.**

PURPOSE

The purpose of this DIRECTIVE is to enhance Public Health in wake of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) global pandemic.

DEFINITION

For the purpose of this Directive, the following definition shall apply:

Operator: means a person, organisation or enterprise, engaged in or offering to engage in, aircraft operations, and any person who causes or authorises the operation of aircraft, in the capacity of owner, lessee or otherwise, whether with or without the control of the aircraft.

DIRECTIVE

**RESTRICTION OF FLIGHTS WITHIN GEORGETOWN
FLIGHT INFORMATION REGION**

1. With effect from 00:00hrs on Thursday 4th June 2020 until 23:59hrs Wednesday 17th June 2020, the following conditions will apply to all flights within Guyana.
 - a) Transportation of foreign nationals to and from ***all border locations*** is suspended. These includes the following;
 - North West** – Mabaruma, Port Kaituma, Mathew's Ridge, Baramita, Bemichi and also Moruka (accessible via Port Kaituma and Bemichi)
 - West** - Eteringbang, Arau and Kaikan.
 - South and South West** - Orinduik, Itabac, Chiung, Eagles' Mere, Yurong Paru, Lethem, Bashaidrum, Kanapang, Cipo and Camp Jaguar.

- b) Transportation of passengers to all locations shall be allowed at fifty percent (50%) of the aircraft seating capacity. Adequate spacing of passengers must be adopted.
- c) Transportation of all persons who would have visited, stayed, lived, or transited through Brazil and Venezuela within the past thirty (30) days is restricted.
- d) The transportation of cargo and medical supplies shall be allowed during daylight operation. Cargo shall be fully sanitized before loading onto the aircraft in keeping with the Ministry of Public Health guidelines.
- e) Medevac flights shall be allowed at fifty (50%) of the aircraft seating capacity.
- f) There shall be no night operation except for Medevac flights.
- g) The flight crew shall be properly protected with masks and gloves for all authorised flights in keeping with Ministry of Public Health guidelines.
- h) All passengers are required to wear masks in keeping with Ministry of Public Health guidelines.

2. Any air operator who contravenes this Directive commits an offence against the Civil Aviation Act 2018 and shall be subjected to the penalties specified in Section 88 of the Act.
